Workforce Development Center

Our Workforce Development Center provides vocational rehabilitation services to people with disabilities as well as those with disadvantaging conditions. Goodwill strives to restore an individual's dignity, self-respect and self-worth through integrated programs of evaluation, personal adjustment and skills training, resulting in permanent employment.



Professional Janitorial Service

We offer a high quality commercial cleaning service at a competitive rate. Our cleaning service is available on a contract or non-contract basis, provided daily, weekly or as needed during the day or after hours.

Career Development Center

Goodwill's Career Development Center helps people gain and maintain employment at their highest level of ability by learning various skills through services such as career assessment and exploration, resume building, interviewing skills, online job search techniques and dressing for success. Through workshops and one-on-one instruction, we strive to help each individual find a job to ensure their continued success.



'Maximum Independence Scholarship'

Recognizing the ever-increasing need for financial assistance to help defray the cost of higher education, we have implemented a scholarship program to help select seniors in our territory attend college. Our mission is to help people with disabilities and disadvantages achieve maximum independence; it is our hope that with our financial assistance, a few select high school seniors who aspire to continue their education can indeed achieve that dream.



Goodwill Housing

A 74 apartment unit that provides housing and services specially designed to meet the physical, social and psychological needs of elderly citizens and individuals with disabilities. Our goal is the health, security, and independent living of our residents.

Adult Day Service

Our Adult Day Service is a community-based group program designed to meet the needs of functionally impaired adults. This is a structured, comprehensive program that provides a variety of health, social and other related support services. Regular day service attendance can give working families the comfort of knowing their loved one is being cared for by licensed and certified health care staff.



Youth Service (For Youth with Special Needs)

Goodwill's Youth Service provides a safe place for special-needs youth in the Lawton/Fort Sill community. A DHS Licensed Center with certified staff that operates during the school year with a before and after school program and all day during summer with a summer camp. Each youth has an individual plan of service

VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance)

'You Earned It—You Keep It' Goodwill offers FREE income tax preparation during tax season at some of our retail stores for those who qualify. Goodwill's IRS Certified tax preparers are trained to ensure that taxpayers receive all the tax credits to which they are entitled. Through the VITA program, we prepare basic tax

We were able to serve almost **5,500** people in our communities during 2013.

We were very thankful for the simple gestures of giving your loose change and your donations of gently used clothing and other items. Your generosity provided us the means to employ over 200 people, as well as provide all the services below:

Some of the services we provided were: free voluntary income tax assistance (VITA), free coats for individuals in need, thousands of dollars in free vouchers to families and individuals in need, presents for our DD (developmentally disabled) clients during the holidays, fund-raising dollars to over 50 non-profits in our region, and 15 scholarships. In addition to these services, we were able to continue to provide Adult and Youth Day Services Art Exhibits, summer youth program, Career Development opportunities, housing to the elderly and developmentally disabled, and vocational services to our DD clients.

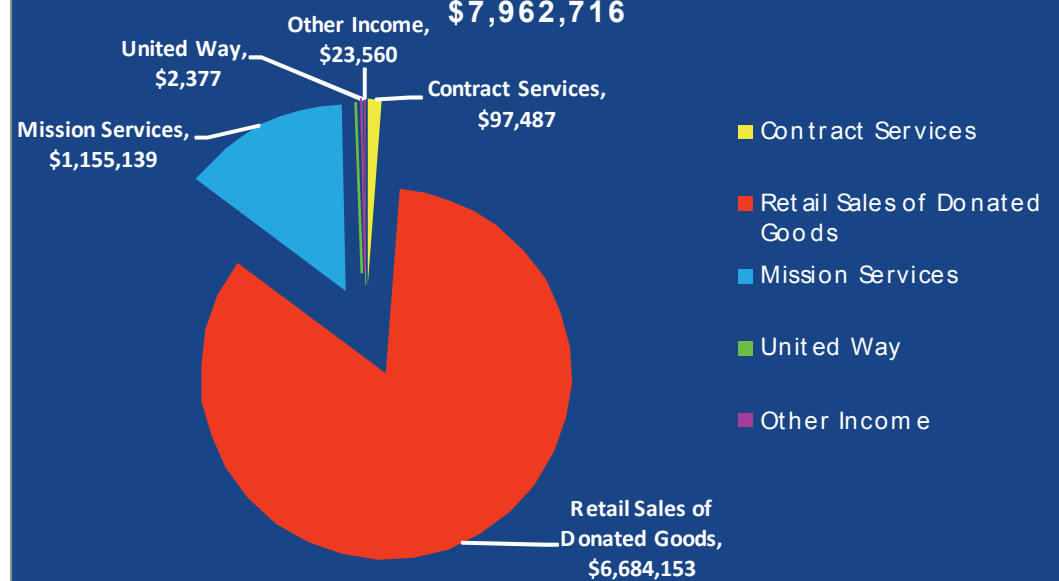

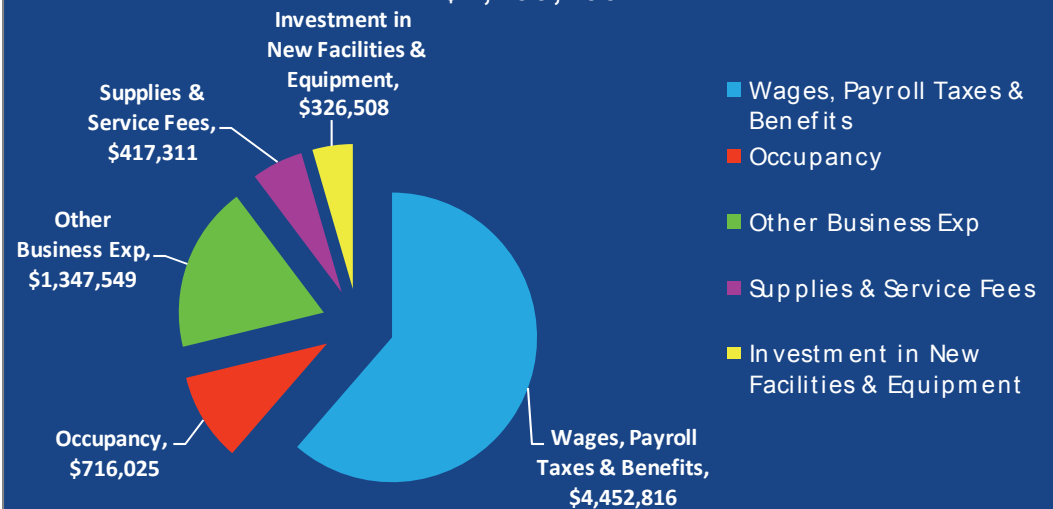
In 2013, The Community Gave to Goodwill
